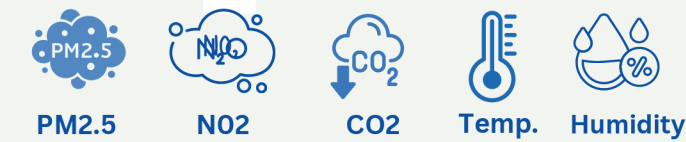

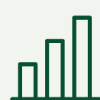

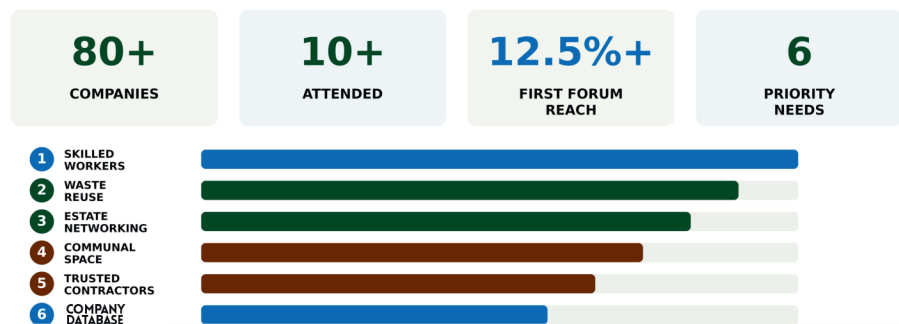
EMPOWERING CHANGE: VOLUNTEERS CHAMPION LOCAL SUSTAINABILITY ACTION IN MERTON

RSFH grew from the award-recognised Empowering Change pilot with Sustainable Merton, delivered between October 2024

and February 2025. The project involved Roehampton students in urban gardening, zero-waste food distribution, and community intergenerational engagement. It received UK Parliament recognition through Early Day Motion 1753, with 18 signatures, and helped shape the Hub's current sustainability work.

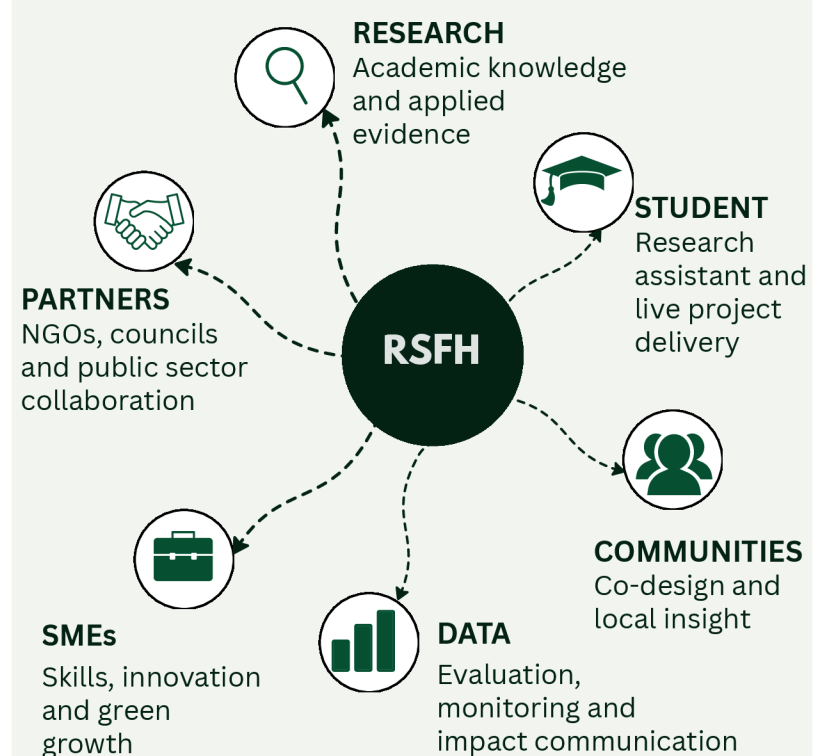
